- Simple header with name, phone number and email address. Street address is unnecessary.
- Education and certifications at the top. Remember to include your cumulative GPA.
- Clinical experience, including hospital, unit, and number of hours
- Healthcare-related work experience, with several bullet points under each employer highlighting your major accomplishments or responsibilities.
- Optional: Healthcare-related volunteer experience
- Optional: Foreign language skills

What to Leave Off

- Objective statement
- Unrelated work experience, such as camp counselor or restaurant
- Memberships and clubs, including honor societies and Student Nursing Association
- Scholarships and achievements, such as Dean's List
- References or "references available upon request"
